Minutes of Last Meeting

Minutes of the last meeting were approved, having been proposed by S Miller, and seconded by H Gledhill.

Matters Arising

Storage at Nafferton Village Hall- Security has been improved, though a door had been left open/unsecured.

Business Cards- S Miller will action this. H Gledhill had some old ones which she will share.

Masons- The informal carol concert for the Masons has been confirmed.

Peasholme Park- S Miller will check which instruments will be needed in the light of the size of the 'floating bandstand'. M Kellett will continue to refine the parking permission re yellow lines/bollards etc. Most likely the Berlingo and trailer will be needed.

Burton Constable- It was recalled that the stage would not be available beyond this year. Decision for next year needs to be considered.

Uniform- This had now been in use, and is in storage.

Library- There had been no interest from Brass Band organisations to archive our old music. Therefore, it is up to us to decide what to keep, what to destroy, and what to digitise. It is accepted that this process will take some time.

Covid 19- Wearing of masks is now optional at rehearsal, but we should all be respectful of others.

AGM- This would be prior to rehearsal on Friday 11th February 2022 at 7.15p.

Christmas Fund Raising- Venues at Hornsea Tesco and Next were mentioned.

Social- Weather forecast indicated a major problem due to uncertainty. Final decision would be made at rehearsal.

Secretary's Report

CRB/DBS- Checking of current/new members must be kept up to date. Two members are in process at the moment.

Child Safeguarding- Exemption Certificate application submitted, and Certificate now received.

Peasholme Park- Much discussion over parking etc. M Kellett to action through his contact.

Queen's Platinum Jubilee 2022- B Hall confirmed that All Saints Church had been booked for Friday 3rd June 2022.

Band Matters

Band Picture- S Miller to recreate the picture from the Drifffield Press, with the Band in Uniform.

Nafferton- Advertising is needed in and around Nafferton now that the Band is formally established in the Village Hall.

CD- there is a possibility of recording a new CD next year- maybe October 2022.

Youth Band- There is a major shortage of players. As this is likely to remain the case for a little time, maybe we could help in some way, for instance storing instruments. Enquiries could be made as to the use of Nafferton Village Hall in some way, linked to Drifffield Silver. We could offer to give help with tuition etc to get the Youth Band going again. M Buckton would speak to the Chair of the Youth Band.

Instrument service- Our bid for funding had not been successful. However, S Miller can organise repairs etc through Brass Instrument Repair in Darlington. We should get the instruments sorted, though members should take responsibility for the day to day maintenance of the loan instruments themselves. It was noted that the cost of overhaul is related to the size of the instrument concerned. Also, that a bulk order could attract discount. It was noted that 4 instruments could cost £1200. S Miller to action.

Percussion Service - This has to be organised under a different scheme from the Brass Instruments.

Insurance- As the value of the instruments has increased, the renewal premium has been raised to keep pace.

Christmas Carols in Nafferton- M Kellett would seek a free date in December. We would need to investigate the capacity of the Nafferton Village Hall under different

seating arrangements. This would be checked prior to rehearsal. Dates suggested were- Sat 4th 7pm, with coffee, mince pies etc. Sunday 19th, 2pm was also proposed.

Tesco- Cash for Bags- K Duck to investigate, M Kellett to follow up.

Bob Dales Memorial Concert- M Buckton to approach ERYBB.

Joan Gledhill Memorial Concert- We should wait until the family are able to organise the visit from France. However, a tentative date was suggested- 7pm, Saturday 23rd April 2022. H Gledhill would attend to the family arrangements, Secretary would contact the Showground/Pavilion to 'hold' a date.

Memorial Concert for Rob Dawson- H Gledhill would arrange flowers. S Dawson would like to present an award in his memory, perhaps at a concert in November. It was requested that family only attend the funeral. S. Miller to represent the Band. A 'Celebration Day' is to be organised in a field in Nafferton, on a date to be agreed in September.

Any other Business

Web site- A profile of Rob Dawson would be posted in the News and Gallery sections.

Vacancies- Euphonium and Trombone players would be sought. Interest in playing any Brass instrument would be welcomed.

Merchandise- stick-ons and iron-ons were now possible as S/M Miller had a new machine, and could print on shirts etc.

Further ideas are still needed. Katherine & Clare would be approached.
