Description: The private & outdoor rehearsing of wind, brass, string and percussion players greater than 6 people (Up to 30 people or current Government instructions in the village hall) . The outdoor space may be a garden.

| Players may be asked to have their temperature taken prior to entering the village hall / Concert Venue | Players | M | If a player displays a temperature of 37.8 degs or higher they will not be admitted to rehearsal / Concert Venue. This does not mean they have CV but to safeguard everyone else this is why they should not enter. (It is not necessary to identify the player.) The player should seek a CV test and inform the Chairman or MD of the result so that track and trace advice can be initiated if required. | L/M | If the CV test is positive, track and trace will be activated as appropriate. | n/a | |
| Players bring a known infection into the rehearsal area. | Players | H | Do not attend a rehearsal Concert if any member of your family has presented the symptoms below or if you have been engaged in an activity that is likely to have exposed you to risk or you are unwell; specifically with these symptoms:- a high temperature >37.8 degs a new, persistent cough a loss of smell or taste any symptoms that might cause sneezing | L | No | n/a | |

The immediate area around the player in the rehearsal hall/ Concert Venue should be free of any water or rubbish when the player leaves rehearsal / Concert. Where possible, players should clean their instrument at home after rehearsal / Concert. | L | No | n/a | |
